

Kennedale Speedway Park Factory Stock Rules Amendment – posted 4/17/18

Any driver attempting to make a claim must have raced two consecutive race nights in the factory stock division at the same race track prior to attempting a claim. Driver making the claim must drive his or her car immediately to the tech area with cash in hand and notify the track tech official immediately of the car they wish to make a claim on and specify what's to be claimed.

The driver of the car that's being claimed shall be given 10 minutes to decide if he or she agrees to proceed with the claim pending tech, once the claimed driver agrees there shall be no backing out.

Any driver that refuses the claim after both cars have passed tech and then refuses to pull the motor shall then be suspended from racing in the factory stock division for a period of four race nights or 30 days whichever is longer.

The car of the driver who is making the claim shall have their car inspected and must pass tech in order to be a valid claim. If claiming car does not pass tech the claim will be void and cash returned to claiming driver and that driver will be disqualified.

Drivers may only claim one motor per Calendar year, any driver that refuses to sell his or her motor will not be allowed to claim a motor for 1 year. Shocks, distributor and carburetors shall also use the same procedures as a motor claim.

Driver may still decline the claim within the first 10 minutes and just lose points and monies for that race only. If driver does not make a decision within the first 10 minutes they will be automatically disqualified.
